

Supplier Agreements and Contracts

It is not our normal practice to complete individual supplier agreements for the following reasons:

Canada Life is a provider of specialised insurance services therefore it is not appropriate for it to enter into generic supplier agreements. As mentioned below, the policy of insurance governs the contractual relationship between Canada Life and its policyholders.

Canada Life is a Data Controller, not a Data Processor. This is in respect of information or data which is provided to us directly or via the policyholder's agents. It is therefore not appropriate for Canada Life to enter into a data processing agreement with a policyholder.

Canada Life's policy document represents the legal contract between Canada Life and a policyholder. This outlines the terms and conditions on which the insurance cover is provided, which must not be over-ridden by any other contract.

Canada Life is a UK based insurer and is therefore subject to relevant legislation and regulation that applies in the UK. Therefore legislation and regulation that applies outside of the UK will not be applicable.
